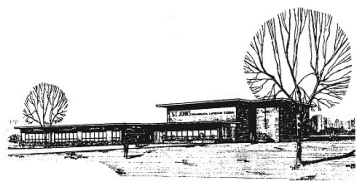

As the holidays approach, many families are considering traveling to other states and/or countries. Please look at the link below for travel guidelines. Also, in an effort to keep others safe, St. John's will require any student travelling out of the country to quarantine at home for at least the **first 3 days before returning to school**. Most importantly, all travelers are advised after travel to monitor themselves for COVID-19 symptoms and isolate and get tested if they develop symptoms.

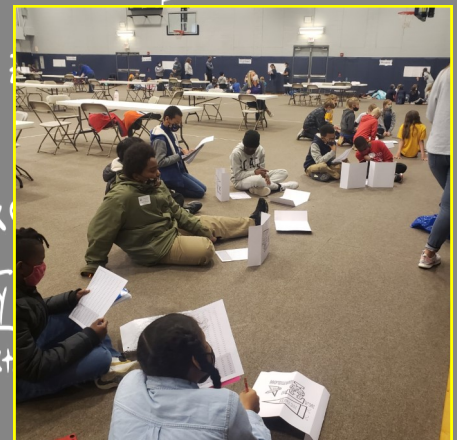
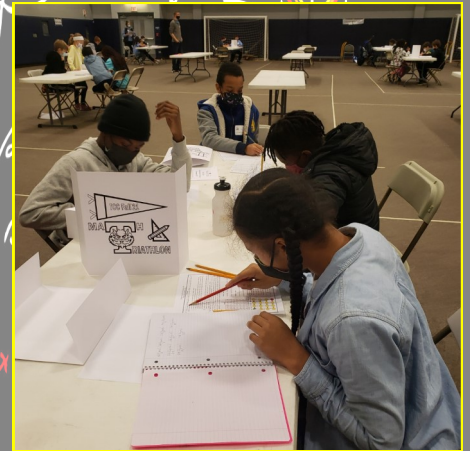


Our tardy procedures are outlined in the School Handbook and referenced below. Students who are tardy miss the beginning of their morning classes, and they also cause a distraction when they arrive late to class. Students who are frequently tardy have lower GPAs and lower scores on standardized assessments. As tardies accumulate, St. John's assesses a tardy fee. Please read the procedure below as outlined on page 12.

Tardy - A child is marked tardy if he/she is not in the classroom at the ringing of the 8:00 AM starting bell, unless the student has been given permission by the instructor to be out of the classroom. Tardy slips will be issued from the office. Students are permitted a maximum of **3 tardies** per quarter. After that number has been reached, the parents will be notified that they will be charged **\$10 (for each tardy) per family upon the fourth through sixth tardy and \$25 (for each tardy) for any additional tardies in that quarter**. Please note that tardies are not categorized as "excused" or "unexcused" for purposes of calculating tardy assessments. For the purpose of retention of the grade, five tardies will be the equivalent of one day absence.

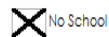
